

UERETARO

Due to its excellent location being approximately 2 1/2 hours to the north west of Mexico City, Querétaro is a popular starting or finishing point for those seeking to explore the colonial cities in central Mexico. Querétaro's historical downtown has a mixture of cosmopolitan bars and restaurants and combined with a wealth of baroque and neo-classical architecture

amongst others. Due to its "busy city" first impressions, this town is often highly underrated. Its historical downtown was declared a national heritage site in 1996 and features impressive old colonial mansions, hotels, and a wealth of churches principally from the 17th and 18th century.

Travelling south we combine modern, cosmopolitan Mexico City to explore the city, colonial heritage, markets and magnificent Aztec pyramids. Enjoy the towns of Puebla and Oaxaca with traditional main squares called 'Zocalos', where people come to stroll in the gardens and you can experience the true Mexican national character.

Stay for 3 nights with two full days to explore. Visit Oaxaca indigenous and colonial heritage and the archaeological site at **Monte Albán** build by the Zapotecs with pyramids, tomb of kings, ancient ball game court and star observatory. (*B*)

Day 6 Full day visit to the surrounding area. Visit Tule's giant tree, over 1,000 years old, whose branches embrace and cover a small church. Teotitlan is known for a long tradition of weaving cloth in colourful, intricate patterns. The archaeological site at Mitla has superb

stone relief patterns on the temple façades and a Mezcal liquor distillery (*B*).

Day 7 Excursion to the artisan town of Arrazola to see the colourful Alebrijes, papier-mâché figures, and the black clay pottery of Coyotepec. Later visit the little known ancient tombs at Zaachila, and the fortress-like monastery at Cuilapan. (B)

Day 8 Transfer to the airport. You may also take a short flight to stay at a beach resort on the Pacific coast at **Huatulco**, **Puerto Escondido or Puerto Angel**. (B)

Cuernavaca

Cuernavaca is the largest city of the state of Morelos. Nicknamed the "city of eternal spring" by Alexander von Humboldt, it boasts an excellent climate all year round. Located only 84km south-west of Mexico City, is a popular destination for both Mexicans and visitors looking to escape the city. It offers beautiful parks and gardens with bandstands, impressive cathedrals and churches, and charming haciendas. Cuernavaca is usually combined with a trip to Taxco (famous for its silver).



Puebla

Puebla is one of the five most important Spanish colonial cities in Mexico and is located approximately two hours to the south east of Mexico City. It was declared a National Heritage site in 1987 and is often visited alongside the colonial town of Cholula which is one of the oldest recorded cities in Mexico.


Cholula has a huge number of churches and we can also admire the largest manmade pyramid in the new world. Puebla offers exquisite cuisine, a laid back lifestyle and an abundance of colonial architecture especially its remarkable cathedral as well as many hidden museums and churches.

OAXACA

Oaxaca is known for its indigenous cultures historically in conflict with a strong colonial heritage. The town is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Zapotec and Mixtec settlements in the Oaxaca Valley date back to 500 BC with the Aztecs arriving in 1440 and the Conquistadores in 1521. The state of Oaxaca maintains a strong indigenous

identity expressed in local life, monuments, and crafts in papier-mâché, woodcarvings, textiles and black pottery. Oaxaca's markets offer a fascinating insight into all these crafts. In addition visit the Centro Cultural, the Baroque Cathedral, Zocalo or experience the many outdoor Festivals including the month long Guelaguetza Festival at Easter.



We take an afternoon excursion to the famous Anthropological Museum, housing a magnificent collection of Aztec and Mayan artefacts, great Olmec stone heads, burial tombs and exquisite pottery and ceramics. We tour the pyramids of Teotihuacan, supposedly the most advanced urban centre of its time (500BC - 700AD) with the Pyramid of the Sun, of monumental scale and grandeur rising 65m high. (B)

Optional excursions to the historic town of Cuernavaca and Taxco, perched on the side of a mountain and renowned for its silversmiths. You may experience the canals at Xochimilco accompanied by loud Mariachi bands, combined with Coyoacán and the Diego Rivera, Freda Kahlo and Trotsky museums. (B)

Days 4-6 Morning departure with your guide and transfer to visit the colonial city of **Puebla**. Continue to **Oaxaca**. Set on a high plateau and encircled by the mighty Sierra Madre del Sur mountains serving as an effective barrier preserving the ancient Indian character. Visit the majestic, Zapotec archaeological site at **Monte Albán**. Day free to explore. (B)

Day 7 Fly to Tuxtla Gutiérrez and on to the Sumidero Canyon. A mighty fissure cutting down 1000m into the earth whose sheer sides are blanketed with lush jungle, home to a variety of wildlife. We take a boat trip along the river and continue to San Cristóbal de las Casas for 3 nights. (B)

Days 8-9 Hidden in the remote mountains, people preserve their culture and traditions in the villages of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantán. There is a fascinating rustic church with a blend of pagan and catholic symbols.

Day free to explore. (B)





Day 10 Drive to **Palenque** and stop at Agua Azul river. (B)

Days 11-12 In the morning we explore the important Palenque Mayan archaeological site. Walk among the ornate pyramids and temples, set on the edge of the rainforest, in an atmosphere of serenity and mystery. In the afternoon we drive to Villahermosa and, if time allows, stop at La Venta Park to

admire the huge Olmec Heads, then fly to Mérida. The main plaza of this historic city is a garden bordered by colonial buildings central to Mexican town life, fiestas and people watching. Next day we tour the colonial heritage of Merida. (*B*)

Day 13 Today we visit Kabah and the extensive site of Uxmal, perfectly restored, showing the intricate stone lattice work and mosaics, a fine example of the ornate Puuc style. The Pyramid of the Magician rises above the surrounding vegetation and overlooks the magnificent landscape of the Yucatán Peninsula. (B)



Day 14 Morning journey to the mighty Chichén Itzá, a blend of the Toltec and Mayan cultures. The monuments here have few decorations and the massive pyramids, temples and astrological observatory are evidence of the impressive power and knowledge of their rulers. Time to visit the site at leisure, avoiding the midday heat and the daytrippers. Overnight nearby. (B)

Day 15 Morning free to go back to Chichén Itzá. Afternoon journey to Cancún airport for your flight home, (B) arriving the following day, Day 16.

Edzna, Day 6

Explore the isolated sites of the Yucatán, dotted with the remains of past, mighty civilisations, small villages, the walled city of Campeche and colonial Mérida. Step back in time at Calakmul, with some pyramids fully restored and others still hidden by encroaching jungle.

Days 8-9 Drive to Oxkutzcab, a small, picturesque Mayan town with a large and colourful fruit market. Continue to Mérida, a colonial city with its buildings painted in soft colours, enclosing delightful, tranquil patios and stay for 2 nights. 



The archaeological site at Tulum is the only ancient Mayan village surrounded by a defensive wall and poised over a 15m high cliff overlooking the sea. The coast here has mostly small, low rise hotels on the beach front, aiming to be a "barefoot paradise". Nearby you can visit the ancient Mavan site of Cobá. with magnificent tall pyramids rising above dense forest, the nature reserve of Sian Ka'an, swim with dolphins or swim and snorkel in the canals and the underground rivers at Xcaret and Xel-Ha. 
